


COMMUNICATIONS ROOF MOUNT

FROM THE TOOLBOX

Pencil and/or punch tool Power drill 6mm drill bit 10mm wrench or socket 4mm hex key Masking tape Zip ties

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IMPORTANT

Read instructions throughly prior to installation. Installation should be performed by a qualified professional.

INSTALLATION

- 1. Place the box where you want to install it inside the vehicle.
- 2. Use a pencil to mark the area where the box will be installed and place a piece of tape over the spot where holes will be drilled then place the box back over the tape holes and use a pencil or punch to mark where holes will be drilled Once drill holes have been marked set the box aside. (Using tape limits burs when drilling through)
- 3. Using a drill and 6mm drill bit, drill through the roof then remove the tape. Use a file to remove any jagged burs.
- 4. Install radios and other components into the mount route wiring through the holes at the back of box to the left and right. You will route wires to which hole is closer to where wiring can be zip tied to the cage.
- 5. Remove the adhesive backing from the supplied foam and place it on the edge of the box that will make contact with the roof.

NOTE: An extra set of hands may be needed to complete the next step.

- 6. Drop the screws into the holes on the roof and align the screw holes on the box Add washer and nuts to the bottom by hand hold it up.
- 7. Use a 4mm hex key on the screw and 10mm socket for the bolt.
- 8. Wiring can be run down one of the pillars and held in place with zip ties. Ultimately wiring placement is at the discretion of the installer.



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
